

### 1. INTRODUCTION

POLIS University in 2006, opened a Master's degree program in Architecture and Urban Design, a branch that was highly required by students in that period, but also in the upcoming years. In 2007, another program, the MSc.Planning & Urban Management, was opened. In the following years, new study programs were opened: BSc. Art and Design (2010), BSc Environmental Study (2011). In 2010, six new study programs were opened in the second cycle (Joint Master Degrees with IHS / ERASMUS University, Rotterdam, and with the participation and the contribution of Lawrence Technological University, Detroit). In 2012, the decision no. 270, dated 20.05.2016, The Albanian Government approved the amendment of the status of private institution of higher education "POLIS University". In the same year, the MASH (Ministry of Education and Science) also give the opportunity to offer studies of the Third Cycle, Doctorate (Joint Program with the Ferrara University, Italy). In 2013, U\_POLIS opened new branches: BSc. Civil Engineering and professional Schools in Energy Efficiency, in acordance to the fields of interest of U\_POLIS. The MBA Master Program, in collaboration with IPAG Business School in Paris, opened in October 2014.

In this report, Alumni collected employment data of each of them. Students are contacted via e-mail, mobile or even through conversations or meetings, and so some cases were highlighted as more successful than the others. From this data we understood that, the highest percentage of alumni are in the MSc Architecture and Urban Design and MSc. Urban Planning and Management Programs, as they are branches that have been 10 years since their opening. Other branches are new and have few graduates.

Civil Engineering or Environmental Studies and Energy Efficiency, as they are relatively new programs, are in the early years and have released few professionals in the market, some of them still attend Master studies. It is expected that, in the coming years, this alumni number will create a more critical measure and increase the number of employees. Professional Master Students study and are employed at the same time. At the moment they attend a master's degree at U\_POLIS, but the university aims to pursue these alumni in improving their career.

A support for the employment of the students has been the Career Office through its contacts with various firms: Studio architecture, engineering, or design, construction companies, Ngo, etc., has made possible the relatioship of graduate students with the market demands. These links have proved to be successful, as a large part of the students are employed, leaving very good impressions and professional growth in their careers.



### 2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this report is the joint information of former alumni students of POLIS University, their professional, academic, civil engagement and their general experience. The forms used in this study looked at the general experience that these alumni have had with POLIS University, since entering the University as a student until their graduation, then graduation, in a professional career. Students were contacted via social networks, directly on the phone and via e-mail.

The data collected from this study, converted into several statistics, serves the University in drawing several conclusions about the strengths and weaknesses of the curricula and where one can work harder to increase the quality of Alumni at the moment. Dealing with the labor market, improving relations with alumni by following them in their careers and also serving in the field of marketing domestically and internationally as well as informing future students of the forerunners and their career achievements. In this study, data was collected for 566 POLIS Alumni graduates from 2010 to 2016. The number of Alumni students who responded and gave their thoughts and experiences from the EE cycle to the Professional Master and Phd was 95%. The highest percentage is the Master of Science Program in Architecture and Urban Design and Master of Science in Urban Planning. Other branches are new branches and have few graduates in number. It is expected that in the coming years this alumni number will create a critical scale and increase the number of employees. The approach contact with graduates (through the ALUMNI structure) as well as the wide network of partners provide U\_POLIS with a very good access to the needs and demands of the labor market. This extended network also plays an important role in the further extension of the social impact that U\_POLIS intends to achieve.



# 3.1.2 Total number of graduates from 2011-2016 calendar year, in relation to employment



The Aluflor Company has voiced a very positive comment to Polis Alumni who are walking with success stories in their career and now they have made a new request for two-three architects a civil engineer and an Engineer Implementation. 


Difference with other branches in employment because it is a new branch and also students continue master studies.

### 1.2 Public-Private Employment Level







The chart 3 tells us that the level of employment in the private sector occupies the most significant share of the employed, as the private sector offers more jobs and is more accessible.



The following graphs show all study programs divided by percentages by employment sector and data for graduates who are continuing their studies.



































### 4.1 SUCCESS IN PROFESSION

In this group are mentioned those Alumni, who during these years, have managed in succeeding in their professional fields.

#### 1. "StudioArch4"

Gjergji Dushniku (arch), Rezart Struga (arch), Klaudio Cari (arch), Lorin Çekrezi (arch).



StudioArch4 was founded in 2011 by four Alumni of Architecture and Urban Design program, who

graduated in 2013 and a part of them also attended Professional Master Studies at Polis University. This studio deals mainly with design, but their work varies depending on the type of design program and the level of intervention. The basis of their work is always the innovation of creating architectonic spaces and solving different problems at the same time. Competitions are a tool they use to test themselves but also to collaborate with international studios. Some of them are: the competition for the Isle of Berat, the Lake Park Entrance Competition in collaboration with AZPML (Alejandro Zaera Polo & Maider Laguno), a global-scale architectural firm or the ALN (ArchitekturbüroLeinhäupl + Neubernje), a German studio operating in Bavaria since 1978, specialized in public facilities such as hospitals and schools. In co-operation with this studio they won the second prize in the competition of Master's Plan for the "Student City". Finally, this studio has been qualified as one of the 17th representatives of Albania in the Mediterranean Biennale.

### 2. Lorena Xhaxho (arch.)

After completing her studies in Architecture and Urban Design at U\_POLIS for five years now, she lives in Ohio and is part of the staff of one of the most known companies in Cleveland, Ohio, USA. Architectural Vision Group Company LTD mainly deals with large projects such as schools, stadiums, etc. Lorena herself says that her achievement comes as a result of the knowledge and the love for work Polis has given to her during the study years.



### 3. Juxhin Balliu (arch.)

Juxhini is an architect who has a super success story of his career. He managed to merge his profession as an architect and interior designer with another business, a successful store also known as the Nova Architect Studio, which dealt not only with the design but also the implementation of projects, using furniture that this firm itself traded. With its success in the market, this studio managed to hire many colleagues of Juxhin, former Alumni of Polis



University. This is not the only successful business of Juxhin, but another success story is Mon Cheri, a project that combines its profession as a designer with business, thus creating environments with a unique architectural design and relaxing space.



# 4. Klaudia Llupo (arch.)

After several different design experiences as members of Nova Architecture for four years and her participation in various interior projects, Klaudia today works as a freelance architect.

#### Interview:

I've been part of the *Nova Architect Studio* for four years. My different experiences include both interior and exterior design. Polis has helped me to create a clear concept of how an architectonic project works and clear ideas about a functional and tasteful design. It has also helped me to increase self-esteem and

quality design. Some of my works and projects are: designer of bars and coffee shops of Mon Cheri, Designer of showrooms such as Ami event, Primavera House, Big Ben pub, Opium sushi bar, Millennium restaurant, Baby Drive stores, Bio Mia market, interior at the Rolling Hills complex, etc.

### 5. Visar Haxhibeqiri (arch.)

Visari, a former Kosovo student, has completed Master's degree in Architecture and Urban Design and later he returned to his hometown to practice his profession as an architect. He is the cofounder of the "Cooperation Design - Atelier for Architecture and Urban Design" platform, and is also employed in the NGO "Cultural Heritage without Borders" in the field of restoration.



# Interview:

After completing the first cycle of studies, Bachelor, at the Faculty of Civil Engineering and Architecture in Pristina, I started to work as an architectural technician in the studios of my former professors, as a designer. Later, I attended Master of Science in Architecture and Urban Design at Polis University in Tirana, where for two full years I sailed with the infinite academic possibilities, offered by the university in question. After this experience, I started working in Kosovo in the field of restoration, revitalization and reconstruction at CHWB - Cultural Heritage without Border, where the main focus has been the treatment of architectural heritage objects. Since 2012, together with several other architects, we have established the Cooperation Design platform, which has always been engaged in a variety of different Urban and Architectural projects.

Polis University gave me the opportunity to open my horizon in the theoretical, artistic and philosophical part, which could then concretize in the architectonic field. So, the experience in Polis had a tremendous transformational influence on me, where from the technically correct architect (urbanist / designer) but cool of reading and interpreting contexts, gave me the philosophical nature of creation of spaces. There is no better place than Polis University to clarify the architect's position towards the understanding of the process of creation, starting from inspiration, idea or concept to its concretization, in work and space. All this transformation of my beliefs and practices about everything that has to do with the world of architecture was thanks to the existence of Polis, thanks to the highly qualified staff of Albanian and international lecturers and without forgetting the social life inside POLIS.



### 6. Loft Arch

Fatjon Molla (arch.)

Fatjoni, after completing his studies at U\_POLIS, was hired in an architectural studio at Atelier Martel, Paris, where he became part of some architectural projects. In 2014, he founded an architecture studio called Loft Architects, specialized in architectural and interior projects and in designing special products. This studio is based in Tirana but its projects extend all over Europe.



### Interview:

My story as an architect started in 2011 at NOVA Architect Gallery, where for two years I have worked many interesting projects and very important at the same time, which taught me a lot about the technical development of the projects, as well as the relationship with the clients. My experience as architect expanded in Paris, where for 8 months I was employed at Atelier Martel, an architecture studio. During these months, I worked with great projects such as: the Swiss Hospital in Paris; 35 Collective Housing; Competition of 120 Collective Housing in NYON, Switzerland; Specialized housing for people with special needs; Restoration and extension of a professional re-education centre in Saint-Etienne, etc. My experience in Polis has been very beautiful and intensive. During my endurance in Paris, I was familiarized with the teaching methods there and with the work culture, as it was very similar to the spirit and philosophy of U\_POLIS. There I realized that the experience at Polis University has played an important role in my development as an Architect.

### 7. Ervis Lila (plan.)

Ervisi, after studying at Polis University in Urban Planning and Management, continued his master's degree in Sweden. Immediately after that, he was successfully employed in a planning studio in Sweden, which mainly deals with regional planning, but also on the city scale. Employee feedback has been very positive for Ervis's education, work culture and knowledge acquired in our University.



### 8. TAK-FAK Company

Ester Nuriu (Bsc. Art Design), Amela Fejzo (Bsc. Art Design), Raisa Myftia (Bsc. Art Design)

This Professional Services Agency was created by the initiative of a group of girls graduated in Art & Design. They have managed to create a business that intertwines with their profession. Through contacts with different firms or businesses, they provide clients with the implementation of interior projects or other electrical or hydraulic services, with the help of an employed staff.





### 9. Arnisa Jahaj (arch.)

Graduated in Architecture and Urban Design, today Arnisa lives and works in Manhattan, USA. She has managed to be hired as an architect and exercises her profession, complemented by university education, with all the potential and the appropriate capacities for the American market as well.

### Interview:

I work in an architecture studio in Manhattan, New York, a private studio called Case Development, Inc. After arriving in Manhattan, I legalized the Albanian diploma and now I am employed as a full-

time architect. I mainly deal with building permits, interior design, design and constructive arrangement and even with customer consulting. Projects are mostly residential houses.



### **4.2 SUCCESS IN POLICY**

In this group are included those Alumni, who during these years have managed to succeed in key positions in state administration and political forums.

1. Nevin Bilali (arch.), Advisor of the Mayor of Tirana, Erion Veliaj.

Nevin's position in the Municipality of Tirana comes as a result of her engagement in Albanian politics, but also because of her professional and managerial growth, since the university formation. Her position as an advisor focuses on architecture and urban planning issues, thanks to the excellent knowledge and experience gained during the University studies, the group work culture, organized during studio courses, and workshops, organized with foreign and Albanian lecturers.

### Interview:

The innovative spirit during my studies at POLIS University has

helped me to have a cleaner and richer perception concerning architecture and urban design.

Architecture is a process ... a non-linear but interactive process, not static but dynamic, not only intellectual but also abstract, as well as organic and concrete.

Light, space, quietness, form, all these have the power to transform even the most common space. These are notions for which POLIS University is the co-founder of my convictions today. Brixhilda is an alumni who, after studying at U\_POLIS, left for several years in America. There she legalized the Albanian diploma and practiced the profession as an architect, also by obtaining a local license. After a period of time there, she returned to Albania for family reasons, where she successfully manages her family restaurant-hotel business, expressing good creative and



management skills. Beside other commitments in the city of Librazhd, she successfully manages, for several years, the Youth Forum of the Socialist Party.

# **3. Joleza Koka, (arch.),** Ex-Chairwoman of FRESH, currently a member of the City Council, Tirana

Joleza is an architect who has been very active in collaboration with the Alumni colleagues of the same year. After university studies, she started the Master's Degree in "Urban Social Development and Human Resources" at POLIS University, helping her in issues regarding Management and Urban Policies. ### 4. Edona Gjonaj (bsc. ing.)



### 9. Mario Shllaku (Planner)



The completion of university studies for Urban Planning and Management at Polis University has been one of the best investments, having an impact not only in my educational and professional formation, but also in social and moral formation, as well. Today, as a master student of an international program such as Erasmus Mundus, in the European Spatial Policy and Regional Development (Netherlands-Sweden), I am aware that I have studied at a university that is increasingly trying to approach the Western model of studies. This has helped me not to feel the



difference of levels with Western students and to be competitive in an international study environment. Of course, I must emphasize the importance of lecturers at Polis University, where a large number of them try to co-operate with students at a college-to-college level more than student-lecturer. It was exactly one of these professors who encouraged me to apply for the study program where I actually am.

Also, I have to admit the fact that I have never been part of the students with absolute grades, 9-10 in each subject. However, I managed to get a scholarship in one of the best programs for a Planner. I never doubted the fact that I could do this program, since I came from Polis University with a CV, said with conviction, that students from any other university in Albania (perhaps more broadly when compared to my international friends) would envy me. Without any doubt this was one of my strongest weapons, for which Polis University students should be proud of. We have the chance and the opportunity to apply theoretical knowledge on practical issues much earlier than our peers. This is because Polis University has initially created a spirit of cooperation and student integration into various projects, where it has always been one of the main partners. In conclusion, having studied at Polis is 'cool' and relatively fashionable. I think students and ex-students have a kind of image that makes them distinguishable from others.

It was originally a doctor's villa, then after the '45s it was inhabited mainly by the generals and after the '90s it was left in full abandonment. Four new architects took and fixed it up as a space which was conceived as a centre for art exhibitions, national and international, and as a study place in Tirana, open every hour of the day and




night.200 people every day come and leave the "Destil" Villa, mainly young architects, who are familiar with each other and enjoy socializing with a place that is not just a café. They design, collaborate and study together. From their experience as former architecture students, with long-time working hours and group work, they felt the need to create a wider spaceto work on their projects, creating a mixture of simplicity and abstraction that are intertwined perfectly, allowing interaction in a social space. The design is used as an instrument to produce comfort for "Destil" visitors.
